Cadetship Expression of Interest

Overview

The Cadetship Program is a Commonwealth Funded Program that aims to provide professional employment experience and support to Indigenous Australians, whilst they undertake studies to gain formal qualifications.

Successful applicants, known as 'Cadets', will be eligible to receive a Study Allowance of up to \$12,000 (GST exclusive) and a Book / Equipment Allowance of up to \$1,000 (GST exclusive).

Cadets will be required to engage with an employer for a period of 12 weeks of paid employment in a role that relates to their undertaken course of study. If you do not have an employer that aligns with your undertaken course of study, AFL SportsReady can assist you in identifying an employer.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply, applicants must:

- Be of Aboriginal Australian descent and/or Torres Strait Islander descent;
- Identify as an Aboriginal Australian and/or Torres Strait Islander;
- Be accepted as an Aboriginal Australian and/or Torres Strait Islander in the community in which they live or have lived;
- Be enrolled on campus at a university located in Australia;
- Be enrolled for their first undergraduate degree course (*applicants who are undertaking their first combined undergraduate degree course or are undertaking an Honours/Masters year as part of a first undergraduate degree course, may also be eligible*);
- Be studying full time (*unless in their final year, semester of study, for which applications will still be considered*); and
- Provide proof of enrolment.

Please note that all Cadets will need to:

- Notify AFL SportsReady regarding any changes to their circumstances that may affect their Cadetship; and
- Ensure that they notify Centrelink of their successful application and allowance payments.
