



## FIRST NATIONS SCHOOL-BASED TRAINEESHIPS



A training program that offers First Nations students the option of undertaking paid, part-time work whilst completing Year 11 and 12.

Students will receive valuable work experience with a host employer and will earn a Nationally recognised qualification.

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS TO FIRST NATIONS STUDENTS?



Work one day a week while completing year 11 and 12



Earn a salary (National training wage)



Gain essential work experience



Complete a Nationally recognised qualification



Gain credit towards your senior secondary school certificate



Potential to explore career opportunities with your host employer



Receive career support through an AFL SportsReady First Nations Mentor

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO BE PART OF THE PROGRAM?

The program is open to all students who:

- Identify as Aboriginal and/ or Torres Strait Islander
- Are at least 15 years of age
- Commence senior secondary school in 2025

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### HOW MUCH WILL I BE PAID AS A TRAINEE?

All Trainees are paid under the relevant modern award – please contact our First Nations recruitment team for further information

### WHAT QUALIFICATION WILL I BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE, AND DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR IT?

Depending on the state and territory, Trainees will undertake a fully funded Cert II Workplace Skills or Cert III Business Qualification

### WHAT SUPPORT WILL I RECEIVE AS A TRAINEE?

All trainees are assigned an Employment Coach and Educator for support throughout the traineeship. First Nations trainees also receive the support of a dedicated Mentor to provide personal, cultural & career pathway support

### HOW MANY HOURS DO I HAVE TO WORK?

Trainees will work one day per week (7.6 hours) onsite with their host employer

### WHEN DO I START?

The school-based traineeship commences on 6 January 2025

Applications close on Friday, 4 October 2024
